

Prom Dress Code Guidelines

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Proms are memorable events in the lives of our students. In order to ensure that students understand what constitutes appropriate attire, a set of guidelines has been developed:

- Students are required to wear formal dresses, suits, tuxedos, or sports coats.
- Excessive cleavage is not allowed.
- Dresses may be backless as long as the back is not cut below the natural waistline.
- Dresses must not have a slit that exceeds mid-thigh (natural fingertip length).
- Dress length must be mid-thigh (natural fingertip length) both in the front and back.
- No bare-skin midribs are permitted.
- Dress shoes must be worn.
- Canes and ball caps are not permitted.
- Pants should be sized appropriately and should not sag below the hips.
- Shirts must remain buttoned up to the second button from the collar at all times.
- All attire must be appropriately sized and appropriate for dancing.

School personnel will monitor student arrivals and enforce the dress code at the door and in the ballroom.
